

PGY1 Year

The year is divided into 13 blocks of 28 days.

Inpatient Psychiatry	7 blocks
Neurology (both outpatient/consultation)	2 blocks
Inpatient Medicine	A minimum of 2 blocks
Ambulatory Medicine	1 block
Selective primary care (inpatient medicine, pediatrics, or emergency medicine)	1 block

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PGY2 Year

Inpatient Psychiatry	6 months
Consultation/Liaison Psychiatry	3 months
Outpatient Child & Adolescent Psychiatry	1 month

Addiction Medicine/Psychiatry	1 month
Emergency Psychiatry	1 month

PGY2 residents also participate in an outpatient continuity clinic a half day a week on their academic day.

PGY3 Year

100% outpatient plus call responsibilities. Clinics include Ventura County Behavioral Health clinics, CMH outpatient clinic, and electives*.	12 months
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PGY4 Year

Ventura County Medical Center consult liaison, geriatric psychiatry, and electives*.	12 months
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Electives include chief resident inpatient, chief resident outpatient, forensic, consultation/liaison, community psychiatry, further psychotherapy, cultural psychiatry, and additional research.
